Dr. Mickey & Mrs. Beth Myers Residence "Story Book Cottage" 169 N. Crest Rd.

The House - Built in 1927, this Dutch Colonial home was patterned after the "Glen Falls" style home featured in the Sears & Roebuck Catalogue of the 1920's.

The Gardens - The Myers began gardening this property soon after moving in over eight years ago. They hired me about three years ago to help add to their vision of a Story Book Cottage! I was more than happy to oblige.

Collections - Beth Myers is a collector of Fairy, Elves, Gnomes, etc.. garden art and one may see amazing examples throughout from Celtic Bird Baths to Magical Mushrooms and charming Miniature "Faery Gardens". Both owners are animal lovers (Dr. Myers is a well known local Veterinarian) and this shows in their St. Francis statues and many whimsical animal sculptures that abound.

Challenges - I tried to create separate garden rooms that offer different experiences in each. The Upper Level needed screening from the street and the creation of evergreen walls to offer privacy and year-round interest. This is the most formal area of the garden and includes English - Style plantings with blooming shrubs and loads of roses and perennials. The Middle Garden contains seating areas, a firepit and an amazing "man made" stone grotto crowned by a contorted weeping Atlas Blue Cedar. I designed an iron "pergola" type structure to add some shade and interest to the large retaining wall that holds back the parking area above. This wall is covered in custom painted murals. The also custom designed wrought iron pergola is covered in flowering vines some of which are even evergreen! Don't miss the fine collection of Camellias along the Magnolia Wall. The Lowest Levels are the most informal and contain lots of interesting tree specimens and shrub varieties and a large green rambling lawn. Several of the historic trees and shrubs date back to the original owners of the home. I'm sure you will agree that the final result is "Magical" as the owners intended!
